Summary

This pay circular informs employers of the pay arrangements for employees covered by the Agenda for Change (AfC) agreement in Wales.

Action

The revised pay scales for 2023/24 as set out in this circular apply from 1 April 2023 and are as follows:

- To increase the pay scales for all bands by 5% on top of the pay scales set out in AfC(W) 03/2022.
- To amend Band 1 and the entry step point of Band 2, so that the salary scales match the top step point of Band 2.
- > To increase the sleeping and on call allowance by 5%.

All other allowances, fees or payments of the NHS terms and conditions of service handbook remain unchanged.
